7. Director Update

Branch statistics- September FLM hosted 898 patrons and circulated 803 items;
27 activities were enjoyed by 447 people. Ten new cardholders were welcomed-6

- juveniles and 4 adult, a new school staff member and a new student. SWLPLD internet was accessed 214 times by 27 different users.
- September-Sunnyside hosted 1104 patrons and circulated 672 items; 31 activities were enjoyed by 391 people. Nine new cardholders-5 adults, 1 juvenile, and 3 new students. SWLPLD's internet was accessed 371 times by 48 different users.
- 65 unique titles were accessed via Hoopla.
- SWLPLD has gratefully received Grants from SIPA, DEF, Ballentine, CLEL, and CSL for technology upgrades, furnishings, STEAM supplies, literacy programs, early literacy supplies, and circulation materials.

8. Strategic Planning Committee update/Kline Property

- A. Septic
 - It has failed and an engineered system will be procured in the future via grant, if possible.
- B. Electric
 - An estimate of \$2500 to fix minor problems has been received
- C. Water
 - The well is non-potable and is only suitable for toilets and sinks. Potable water dispensers will be used for drinking.
- D. Propane heaters- will be dismantled after November 11th.
